Dear Chair Carr:

As people of faith, we oppose this proceeding to pressure the TV ratings board into labeling children's programs that include transgender and nonbinary people. The FCC does not have authority to act: the ratings system is maintained by a private industry board, not the government because the First Amendment requires the FCC to stay out of this kind of programming decision.

Not only is this proposal beyond the FCC's authority, it is offensive to us and the more than 5 million children in this country with LGBTQ+ parents. Treating these families' stories in television programming as equivalent to violence or sexual content is wrong and amounts to government-sanctioned stigmatization of millions of American families.

Our faith calls us to stand by all of God's children. LGBTQ+ people are made in God's image and deserve respect and celebration, not a content warning. The FCC should close this proceeding rather than sowing division by inventing problems to threaten children and families.
